The Kemper and Ethel Marley Foundation is a private foundation dedicated to supporting Arizona and causes that help those who live and work in Arizona. With assets of more than \$100 million, the Foundation is one of the five largest philanthropic interests in Arizona.

History:

The Foundation was formed in March 1990 by Kemper Marley Sr., shortly before his death in June 1990. Mrs. Ethel Marley was the president until her death in 1997. The family continues to run the foundation today.

- Community enhancement (including parks, zoos and historic preservation)
- Health and human services
- Education for all ages (including agribusiness)
- Medical facilities and research
