The Power of a Loving Grandmother

Georgia, a grandmother to three grandchildren in rural Arizona, came to Arizona's Children Association through Kinship Support Services. She worked with Arizona's Children to obtain her foster care licensing and complete the required training. Georgia's hard work with her case manager has helped create a loving, stable environment, allowing these children to thrive. The children were proud to share their recent high grades in school, obtaining honor roll awards, and were elated to share their community activities like 4-H, softball, and basketball. All of the children report feeling safe and happy living in the home with their grandmother.

It Takes a Village

Three sisters in their 20s were approached by DCS regarding their niece and nephew, who needed immediate placement. These courageous single women came together to help break the family cycles of abuse and substance use problems. They actively engaged in in-home parent education services, including developmental assessments for their children and behavioral health services. Together, they've built a loving and stable environment for the children to flourish.

Community Connections

A 74-year-old caregiver sought guardianship of his 16-year-old granddaughter, whom he has cared for since she was two. He had hoped to enroll her in high school, apply for medical insurance, and obtain benefits for her. Not only was he granted guardianship through our supportive services, we connected him with numerous community resources and a fun-filled holiday party. By working together, our community helped create the support systems needed for this young woman to thrive.
